With all the earlier rain and coolish temperatures we have had, the courtyard garden is flourishing, including a vigorous crop of weeds! These weeds were sprayed with an herbicide earlier and it has taken several weeks for them to finally die, however, many more have sprung up in the meantime. It has been very difficult to keep up with all the weeding! Anyone is invited to lend a hand and pull weeds...they are patiently waiting for you to give them a big hug and a yank! Let me know if you are interested and I can point out all the different intruders. July promises to be a hot month and supplemental watering may also be needed in the garden. We are still planning on re-landscaping many areas once the new sign is installed.

We are hoping to see that new sign yet this summer. We expect an update on the progress at any time and an anticipated date for installation. We are ready!

Since our gutters were cleaned and the downspouts unclogged we are seeing a somewhat noticeable drying of the damaged wall in the sanctuary. Hopefully this indicates that overflowing gutters could be the reason for the wet and damaged wall. We will continue to observe this area hoping that no further wetness or damage will occur, and that it might be possible to start the repairs. We did receive a second proposal for gutter replacement for the church and for the parsonage which is under review.

Our next Workship Day is August 9, as we cancelled the one in June and will not do one in July. In the meantime, we are always open for anything that you would like to do around the church.....just let us know what you want to do and we can help


